FEE STRUCTURE

All players in the Rep A/MD program must register with Blomha - A registration form will be included with your offer of a position on a team or your invitation to the August tryouts.

If you withdraw from the Rep program you forfeit all fees paid (NO REFUNDS).

Please note that Minor Pee wee through Midget age groups are body checking divisions.

INCLUDED WITH FEES

All gate fees (home/away) for all games (league/playoffs) are included in your rep fees.

- Each player will be issued home /away uniforms that they can keep at the end of the season.
- Players will be issued a Blomha Rep jacket in the fall.
- Teams may do their own fundraising if they choose to. All fundraising activities must be approved by BLOMHA in advance. Funds maybe used to offset cost of tournaments or other team functions.
- The maximum number of tournaments that can be entered into is four (4).

EQUIPMENT

Required Equipment and Dress Code:

All players must wear a dress shirt/tie, dark pants and dress shoes. Players will be issued with a Rep jacket.

All players must wear blue helmets and hockey pants with dark blue or black gloves. The glove colour does not apply to goalies.

All Team Officials (Except trainers) must wear dress shirt/tie, Blomha jacket and dress shoes. Trainers may wear a track suit in lieu of dress wear.

LEAGUE SCHEDULE

Novice MD to Minor Midget MD: All MD teams will play ALLIANCE Centres - Hamilton, Waterloo, Kitchener, Cambridge, Brantford Minor, Brantford Church.

The MD level is rep hockey with less travel.

Minor Atom A to Bantam A: Burlington teams in the Minor Hockey Alliance of Ontario play Hamilton, Brantford, Cambridge, Waterloo, Kitchener, Stratford, Woodstock, London, and Sarnia. Teams play Sarnia in a home and away series once prior to December 15th. Teams are then seeded by order of finish and it is possible that a second visit may take place in the second half of the season.

Ice Time

Regular season games will commence in late September. Regular practice ice will commence October 1st and may remain consistent throughout the season with the following exceptions: **tournaments, games, Christmas/March Break, or ice being utilized for other rep teams or other ice user groups.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Players must first try out for "A" in divisions where both "A" and "MD" are offered. However, if they are released from the "A" team they may continue to try out with their respective MD team and if they are released from that they will return to House League.

After the final spring tryouts for each team, players who are invited to the August Conditioning Camps/tryouts are required to sign up at the BLOMHA office no later than May 7th. The fee for these conditioning camps/tryouts is \$150.00 which is not included in your Blomha membership fee and is payable in full at the time of registration.

Players who register for the August Conditioning Camps/tryouts will not receive ***ANY REFUND from the \$150.00 fee regardless of how many sessions they attend.***

August conditioning camps/tryouts will begin on August 9th, 2010 and will be held in the evening Monday through Thursday.

All players, including those who played with the Eagles "A" the previous season and are not trying out for the Eagles must attend the spring tryouts. Players may not play for City Rep and BLOMHA concurrently. Players who are new to Burlington after May 1, 2010 and players released from the Eagles will be permitted to participate in the August tryouts **if positions are available.**

** For those players that are carded in the Spring, the August sessions are mandatory and classified as conditioning camps. These same August sessions are considered tryouts for those players still competing for a spot on a team.
